LIFE MEMBERSHIP FOR FARON

The 2017 Awards and Prize giving night was highlighted by the presentation of Life Membership to current Club Chairman Faron Turner.

Faron joined Orewa in 1999 and has been very heavily involved in surf lifesaving at club, regional and national levels ever since. Rising through the ranks he is now our Chairman.

He volunteers countless hours for us and he thoroughly deserves to be recognised for his contribution which has benefitted us all.

He has been a refreshed lifeguard for 18 years – 14 of those as a patrol captain – sometimes for 2 patrols in one season.

He has been an instructor for 13 years and still spends a huge amount of time running courses to qualify and upskill our members.

He has held several positions as a senior officer of the club including 4 years as Director of Lifesaving and been on the Board for 10 years in total.

For most of the last 15 years, Faron has been the driving force and mainstay behind our lifesaving activity and development and a

significant number of our current members have become lifeguards under his tuition.

Faron’s passion for surf lifesaving is further demonstrated by his contribution at regional and national level with over 12 years holding positions at those levels.

Several years ago he was instrumental in revamping the national lifeguard training programmes into those that used throughout the country today.

Faron holds regional Service and Distinguished Service awards and a SLSNZ Service Award.

Faron continues to volunteer an incredible amount to our club and is truly deserving of becoming a member of an elite club and officially an old man with his awarding of Life Membership.

LIFE SAVING REPORT

We concluded this year once again achieving our mission of keeping our community safe on our beaches. The club exists for that purpose and all activities ultimately lead to placing trained, equipped and enabled lifeguards between the flags. With 180 members collectively putting in over 4200 unpaid hours on our beach, we should be very proud of the efforts our lifeguards made. I continue to also be proud of our ethos that members must first complete a minimum number of patrol hours before competing, this policy focuses our mind on our ultimate purpose and reminds us we are all lifeguards first and foremost. Thanks go to Orewa New World, who once again provided funding to recognize those members who gave extra time to patrolling, through the patrol hours recognition scheme.

Our qualified membership continued to grow, with excellent leadership displayed by Peter and Jodie Wood and the instructing team. We have been recognized for the number and quality of candidates that we put forward, and we will continue to maintain our ambitious standards. Doc Johnsons contribution to growing the lifeguards of the future through his commitment to the Rookie Scheme and bridging the divide between Junior and Senior lifeguards continues to be extremely valuable.

Event guarding is something that has continued to grow as a way for guards to use their skills in different fields, and be rewarded for their efforts. Event guarding also raises substantial funds for the club, and Tom Burgess must be recognised for the hours he puts into safety plans and rostering lifeguards, the skills and commitment he brings to the role are outstanding.

Trevor Keinzley has taken the role of Asset Coordinator this year and done a fantastic job

of ensuring all lifeguards are equipped to perform the role. Skelly, who was acknowledged as the most vigilant lifeguard at Club Awards also leads the Callout Squad, an important after-hours response role. Thanks also to Alaina Green for ensuring our first aid supplies remain stocked and current.

This year, the IRB team has continued to grow, thanks to the efforts of Kevin Stinson and the IRB instructors. Having extra drivers and crew has made the provision of patrols a lot easier, and is leading to the formation of an IRB racing team.

Finally, thanks to Peter Wood as Patrol Coordinator, all patrolling members and the Patrol Captains who lead them. The role of PC is vital, and the young guards who step up to take these roles face many challenges, all of which help to grow them as future leaders in the club. Thanks PC's and Vice PC's who support them, the future of lifesaving within the club is in great shape.

SURF SPORTS REPORT

The season started off extremely well with the Club winning a number Sports Awards at the 2015/2016 Northern Region Awards. I wish to congratulate Lucy Makaea, Grace Kaihau and Tom Burgess for their individual sports awards and this was followed by the Club being awarded the Pool Championship Club of the Year as well as the Masters Club of the year. Soon after this event, our sports team were involved in the first of the 2016 / 2017 sports events. We retained the Northern Region Pool Champs trophy, followed shortly afterwards with a 2nd place at the New Zealand Pool Champs. This was a combined effort of so many people working as a team, with outstanding individual performances. I wish to congratulate Sandra Burrows for taking out 2 World Records during these competitions.

The 'summer' or surf season started off with vengeance with Zac, Stu H, Macca, Cam and Michelle T. Associated with these coaches and managers were a large number of people helping to ensure that things in the back ground went smoothly. This extended to Ben Parker taking over from Zac while he was away finding Viarni. The Zac and Ben partnership together with Cam and Michelle's input appeared to make the season seamless.

Throughout the season the Club and its individual athletes were awarded a number of titles and the Club received its highest placings outside the region for a number of years. This included being placed 2nd overall at the Eastern Regional Champs, behind Mt Maunganui and 5th overall at the NZ Championships in Christchurch. These results showed other Clubs around New Zealand that Orewa is there with the best of them.

The strength of the Orewa athlete has continued to grow and develop. Just a few years ago when I started this role, we were

proud to have a small number of our athletes in the Northern Region training squad and ultimately the competing team. We also had a few members make the New Zealand Youth Development training squad. This season has seen the Northern Region Coach, Manager and Assistant Manager all from Orewa together with nine athletes across the age and gender groups, through to Ella Drinnan being selected to represent New Zealand at the World Pool Champs in Poland. On an individual basis we have had Lucy Makaea win eight national titles across the Pool and Surf Nationals, together with a number of other athletes walk away with medals after being on the podium at the NZ Surf Nationals. This is not to demote other athletes who unfortunately did not make the podium this year as often it is the luck of the wave on the day. I am aware that other notable clubs have started putting plans in place to ensure that Orewa does not continue this trend.

The four yearly World Master Games was held in Auckland in April this year. Due to the strength of surf life saving in Australia and New Zealand, the World Master Games introduced our favourite sport to the World Games. We had a number of teams and individuals competing at Takapuna Beach. In addition, we had also a number of members who Officiated at the games, ensure that the games was something to remember. The results of the games have been included further down in the Annual Report. However, due to its popularity, the Games Organisers are seriously considering running a surf life saving event at the next games in Japan 2021.

None of this would be possible if it was not for our sponsors and donors to the Sports program. Again this season Hopper Construction donated a very large gear trailer, following last years significant contribution to the new surf boat. This trailer will last the Club for many years transporting the equipment

across the country. I cannot go past the contributions that each of Business House and individual sponsors have donated to the Club this year. This money is used to upgrade our sports equipment, deliver a smart uniform to our athletes and assist with the associated competing costs. Every dollar received has been greatly appreciated by all of those involved in the sports program.

The delivery of the sports program could not be completed without the immense hours and effort the volunteers who make up the Sports Committee and the associated sub committees. I thank you for your efforts and acknowledge that the time commitment has been exponential with the ever increasing athlete numbers, processes, procedures etc.

I wish everyone all the best for the upcoming season.
